AAPG Imperial Barrel Award Program Joint College/University Interest Form

Requirements (as stated in the IBA Rules and Operating Procedures, Section 1, Item 7):

- A school that cannot create an IBA team from their current student enrollment may, with IBA Committee approval, combine their students with those from another school within its Section or Region to create an IBA team.
- One school will serve as the host school and be the "office" for the exploration team.
- The host school must have a minimum of three students on the created team and all technical interpretation and preparation of the dataset must be done at the host school using its facilities and supervision.
- This host school will supply the team advisor.
 Transportation to and from the Region, Section, or Global Finals program will originate from and terminate at the individual team member's school.
- Team designation and prize money will be divided between the participating schools and said division must be declared to the IBA Committee prior to the combined team participating in the IBA competition.

If signed agreements are not received from all team members and the Faculty Advisor in the manner above, the team is liable to expulsion from the program.
