Executive Summary

For the second year in a row, a record number of petroleum engineers, geoscientists, financiers, researchers and other energy professionals came together under one roof to collaborate on all things unconventional. By all accounts, this year's event exceeded attendee and exhibitor expectations in building new business relationships, establishing key contacts across the disciplines and showcasing new technologies. Nearly 250 presentations from 30 countries and over 230 exhibiting companies interacted with 5,000 plus participants.

Based on initial URTeC 2014 on site survey results **95%** would recommend URTeC to a colleague, **80%** cited the technical program as what interested them the most and **97%** expressed overall satisfaction with URTeC






