

Datashare 28. Cross section of Tidwell and Salt Wash strata mapped along the Waterpocket fold in Capitol Reef National Park, south-central Utah (see Figure 1 for geographic position of the map). The map covers a 150-m (492-ft)-thick stratigraphic interval over a 13.5-km (8.3-mi) distance. The Summerville Formation and uppermost part of the underlying Entrada Sandstone is added at the base of the cross section to illustrate the position of the Morrison Formation relative to older strata. Thick dashed lines indicate the boundaries between correlated chronostratigraphic units (units 1–4). Selected measured sections are indicated on the map as vertical lines.
