

# EMD's Uranium Committee Report

During the past year since our last report, the Uranium Committee continues to collect information on the expansion of the nuclear power industry and associated uranium exploration and development in the U.S. A. and overseas. So much information is coming on-line that it is difficult to keep up with the volume of new reports, articles, and state and federal resources being made available. Compounding this volume is the evolving picture that is forming on the clear need for expanding nuclear power for electrical generation in the U.S.A.

We have decided to monitor the fields' activities for the time being and schedule to have a new report for release in early 2007. Considerable consolidation of the junior uranium firms is presently under way. In the meantime, we will update the "members only" uranium resources web page as new information becomes available.

With the support and encouragement of Brian Cardott, and the Committee's Special Consultants, the Uranium Committee continues in its mission to provide information on the nuclear power industry, and uranium exploration and mining activity in terms of industry news as well as of meetings, symposia, and training, and in continuing to build the References section on the Web site for use by EMD members and, thereby, to encourage new membership.
